There are some applications available for download that will help with the chore of backing up the files on your PSP.

- PSP Media Manager also has a one click full backup solution built in.

Now Right Click on the SAVEDATA folder and select Copy, as shown in the image above. This leaves the data on your PSP, but also makes a copy in your computer's memory. Now we need to save that data onto the PC's harddrive.

Select any folder on your computer, perhaps even make a new one called "PSP Backups", once selected simply Right Click again, but this time select Paste from the popup menu. You should see the files copied into your new backup folder.

If you have to copy these back to your PSP at any stage, as a recovery, or to put on a different memory card simply do the same in reverse. Browse to your backup folder on your computer, Right Click and select Copy, then browse to our PSP folder and select Paste to put the files onto your PSP. Always make sure that the folder structure is maintained as shown in the above example.

Keep regular backups, it's simple, quick, and can save a lot of headaches!
